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| <p>Subject:</p> <p>The library is available for students to use before school, during break times, lunchtimes and after school. | <p>Curriculum Summary: (KS3, KS4 and KS5)</p> <p>Throughout Key Stage 3, all students participate in our 'Renaissance Learning' programme. This monitors the progress that students make with regard to their reading. It includes regular progress tests alongside reading quizzes once students have enjoyed reading fiction books targeting their reading age.</p> <p>Student progress is shared on a regular basis and families are encouraged to support the development of literacy by reading at home and allowing students to see examples of literacy in the real world.</p> <p>Our library has a wide variety of books that students can borrow free of charge to delight in at home.</p> |
