

# Sixth Form Bursary Fund at a Glance



Bursary	Amount of payment	Method of payment	Criteria for Eligibility
<b>Level 1</b>	Guaranteed £1200 annual payment	£400 every term. Paid in arrears and direct into your bank account	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Are currently in care.</li> <li>• Are leaving, or have recently left care.</li> <li>• Are in receipt of Income Support in their own name.</li> <li>• Are disabled and in receipt of Employment Support, Allowance and Disability Living Allowance.</li> </ul>
<b>Level 2</b> (Discretionary)	Variable	Reimbursed on production of receipts, directly into your bank account or school will purchase items on your behalf.	Have a household income of up to £19,000. The bursary will make specific contributions towards removing factors that the awarding panel considers to be a barrier to participation in education. This can include transport, meals, clothing to meet a dress code, books, equipment or other related costs.
			Have a household income of between £19,000 and £25,000. Students can apply for contributions towards transport, books and trips and borrow a Sixth Form laptop where these are available.
			Have a gross annual household income of between £25,000 and £30,000. Students can request a contribution towards books only.

Where household income is above £30,000, students will be unable to receive any support.

Evidence of household income or evidence relating to other eligibility criteria must be provided.

### **To remain eligible for either level, students must:**

- Have a minimum attendance rate of 90%.
- Have exemplary behaviour.
- Be punctual to all lessons and registration.
- Attend all assemblies and PSE sessions.
- Show an excellent work ethic, make expected progress against targets and attend all examinations.
